

\$60,000 SCHOLARSHIP UP TO 28 CREDITS

For IB Diploma or Career-Related Programme

At the University of Nebraska–Lincoln, admitted IB Diploma and Career-Related Programme students who score at least a 25 on the ACT (or SAT equivalent), and earn a 3.0 GPA are automatically considered for a scholarship worth \$15,000/year (\$60,000 total).

In addition, most IB students earn an average of **25-28 university credits** including 3 hours of credit in Philosophy for completing the Theory of Knowledge course.

IB DIPLOMA or CAREER-RELATED PROGRAMME

Benefits at Nebraska

Most new students who have completed an IB Diploma or Career-Related Programme earn an average of 25-28 university credits at Nebraska, including 3 hours of credit in Philosophy for completing the Theory of Knowledge course. The specific number of earned credits you receive from Nebraska will depend on your IB course performance. The University awards credit in most IB courses with scores of 5 and above.

The University of Nebraska–Lincoln cooperates with the International Baccalaureate Programme in its curriculum and examinations program. The results of the IB Programme are furnished to Nebraska at the request of participating students. Transfer credit can only be earned by examinations presented after students have matriculated at Nebraska.
